Join us on June 1 & 2 as we celebrate the silly, sensuous and sacred music of the German princely courts from the mid 1500's to the late 1600's — the period just before J.S. Bach. In case you don't know us, Cantemus Singers was established in 2008 by our conductor, Michael Erdman, to help expand Toronto's exposure to and appreciation of Renaissance and early Baroque music beyond the sacred 4-part repertoire presented by the average church choir. The 14-voice a cappella ensemble gives equal time to the interesting and evocative secular music of the period, in a variety of languages. Our focus is mainly on the rich 5 to 8 part compositions less often heard by Toronto audiences.
